

# Territorian hailed as flood hero

A TERRITORIAN has been hailed a Queensland Disaster Hero by Premier Anna Bligh.

Accountant Rosemary Campbell, *pictured*, of Merrit Partners helped raise money for her former home town of Theodore,

which was hit by the floods in December and January. "The floods dev-



astated many parts of Queensland and I wanted to do something to help my old home town," she said. Much of the money raised was given to local residents as vouchers that could only be redeemed in local businesses.

"Our goal was to maximise the benefit, helping both residents and businesses and keeping the money in the town. Without a viable business community, Theodore would suffer a double blow from the floods."
